

- 1. All Grace events are tobacco, vape, and alcohol-free.
- 2. This event is for men only (age 12 and up).
- 3. All chili teams must consist of **three men**. Registration takes place online.
- 4. The cook-off site will open at **1:00 PM** for setup, cooking, and/or reheating of chili. Judging will begin at **5:30 PM**. Eating will commence at **6:00 PM**.
- Teams must supply all necessary cooking equipment: propane burner, etc.
 No electricity will be provided on-site your team must be completely self-sufficient for all needs.
- 6. Each chili team is responsible for their own ingredients, utensils, tables, chairs, portable tent (if desired), set-up, and clean-up. Trash cans will be available.
- 7. Chili **CANNOT** be pre-cooked and prepared in advance. Your team's chili must be prepared and cooked on-site. The chili must be homemade and not purchased from a store, or come from a can.
- 8. The chili **must** be made by the team members, and not their wives, girlfriends, or anyone other than one of the three team members. You will be asked prior to judging if only team members made the chili.
- 9. Each chili team is asked to make a minimum of 1 gallon of chili.
- 10. Teams are encouraged (not required) to decorate their team areas.
- 11. Each team will be assigned a number, and given a small cup with a lid for a chili sample. Each team's numbered chili sample will be picked up by an official and delivered to the judges panel for a blind taste-test.
- 12. The name of your chili team, as well as its degree of heat (i.e. mild, medium, hot, super hot) must be written on a notecard and turned in with chili sample.
- 13. Each team will donate its chili for consumption. Bowls, spoons, napkins, and sides (Fritos, crackers, sour cream, and cheese) will be provided by Grace.
